Receive report from Donelle Robinson, USFWS Biologist, on the conclusion of the 5-year review of the Texas blind Salamander and fountain darter.

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

SUMMARY:

The purpose of this item is for the Stakeholder Committee to receive a report from Donelle Robinson, USFWS Biologist on the 5-year review of the Texas blind salamander (*Typhlomolge rathbuni*) and fountain darter (*Etheostoma fonticola*), which were completed on April 26, 2021 and March 30, 2021, respectively.

The purpose of the 5-year review was to assess the species' status as required by section 4(c)(2) of the Endangered Species Act. Based on the evaluation of species, a recommendation could have been made to remove a species from the threatened and endangered species list or suggest a change in the status.

The USFWS concluded that the Texas blind salamander and the fountain darter remain listed as endangered.
