Edwards Aquifer Authority Hosts Inaugural EdTalks Seminar

San Antonio, TX – Today, the Edwards Aquifer Authority (EAA), partnered with the Southwest Research Institute (SwRI), to host its first EdTalks Seminar, titled, *Practical Applications of Climate Model Data for Regional Water Resource Planning*. Attendees learned about up-to-date climate trend projections for the Edwards Aquifer and south-central Texas region, and ways in which climate data can be used within their organizations to help plan for the future changing climate conditions.

Thought-provoking topics ranging from climate data and water resource planning, were covered by Adrienne Wooten, PhD, South Central Climate Adaptation Science Center; Hakan Basagaoglu, PhD, Edwards Aquifer Authority; Debaditya Chakraborty, PhD, University of Texas San Antonio; Sam Sarkar, PE, Halff Associates; and Nicholas Martin, PG, PH, Southwest Research Institute.
